

Dear First Presbyterian Church Family,

Williamson County's "Stay Home Stay Safe" order began at 11:59 p.m. Tuesday, March 24, and it is set to end Monday, April 13. In light of this order, the church office will now be closed until Monday, April 13. Should Williamson County change the order's ending date, we will follow the guidance of their mandate.

The staff will continue to work from home during normal business hours of the church: 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Friday. The church will continue to offer a live-stream service of worship on Sundays at 11:00 a.m. As reported in last week's communication, all in-person church activities continue to be suspended until May 11.

Two staff members will come by the office briefly while the office is closed:

- On Monday mornings, Sue Bell (Financial Secretary) will update financials, run payroll, and process all contributions. This means you can still mail contribution checks to the FPC office during this time.
- On Friday mornings, Christina Bondesen (Office Manager) will be in the office long enough to print, stuff, and mail communications going to FPC members who do not have or use a computer.

The office will remain closed even though Sue and Christina will be present on those two separate days.

Finally, there will also be a Property Committee elder stopping by the church each day to ensure that essential property maintenance is being done.
